*Non-competitive runs in a trial-like setting: Judged, timed & scored
Maximum 300 runs * Max 2 runs per dog per course*

Standard & Time2Beat indoors on ¾-inch rubber matting
JWW under covered pavilion on quarry sand
most crating outside

*Try AKC's new Time2Beat class to encourage speed & accuracy;
all levels compete on the same flowing course of jumps, weaves (12 poles),
tunnels, and either A-frame, seesaw or both*

- **All breeds and mixed breeds** at least 14 months old welcome!
- Pre-entry encouraged to guarantee your runs, avoid a wait in line, and help us prepare; entries also accepted morning of trial from 7:15 to 8:30 a.m.
- \$8 for first entry; \$6 for each additional entry of same dog
- **Pre-enter and save!** Entries postmarked by Oct. 16: \$7 for first entry; \$5 for each additional entry of same dog.
- Training in the ring permitted; however, scoring stops once you use toy or treats, touch your dog, or repeat a contact or successfully completed obstacle. You will then be whistled off at maximum course time.
- **Running order:** Tall to small. We will start with Time2Beat in Ring 1 at 9 a.m.. After that, we will alternate between the two rings, beginning with Exc JWW in Ring 2, followed by Novice Standard in Ring 1, then Open JWW, Open Standard, Novice JWW, and Exc Standard. Two rings but only one running at a time = lots of time for walk-throughs and faster-moving event.
- Food available on site; grounds open at 7 a.m.

Directions to Event Site

Venue is Penn State's Ag Progress Days site, 2710 W. Pine Grove Road (PA Route 45)), Pennsylvania Furnace, PA. Use Gate K.

From the South / East: Take 322 W to the Boalsburg exit (322 Business Route/Atherton St.). Follow 322 Business Route to the second light. Turn left onto Rt 45 West. Go straight until you come to a T in the road at the first stop sign, JCT 26 S / 45 W. Turn left and follow 45 W through the blinking yellow light and the small town of Pine Grove Mills. After this town, you will see many open fields with small blue signs with white lettering that will label the gates in alphabetical order. Gate K is the main entrance to Ag Progress Days. Follow the paved road from this entrance to the Ag Choice Building (approx. 1/4 mile).

From the West: use 322 East to 45 West and follow as above. If using 45 East, Gate K will be on your right.
