## RANDOM DRAW

Entries accepted no sooner than December 2, 2011 at 8 a.m.; finish date for entry into the random draw opening period is December 16, 2011 at 12:00 p.m. Random draw will be held on December 17, 2011 at 2 p.m., at the St. Paul Lutheran Church, 277 W.
